Community

North Ridgeville is a warm, neighborly and growing city of over 35,000 located in Lorain County in Northeast Ohio, 23 miles west of Cleveland, Ohio. We are 15 minutes from Cleveland Hopkins International Airport and 30 minutes from downtown Cleveland. North Ridgeville is a great place to live and work. Cleveland Magazine named the city one of the "Best Places to Live in the Cleveland Area".

School

North Ridgeville High School is a comprehensive four-year public high school enrolling over 1,300 students in grades 9-12. Students are provided a student-centered learning environment with opportunities to engage in 17 Advanced Placement courses, 14 honors/weighted courses, 9 dual-enrolled College Credit Plus courses all on our campus. Our students also participate in dual-enrollment on many college campuses; including Ashland University, Cedarville University, Cleveland State University, Cuyahoga Community College, and Lorain County Community College. NRHS students can participate in more than 30 Clubs, play in 24 Varsity sports, and may attend the Lorain County Joint Vocational School (JVS), in Oberlin, Ohio. The school colors are navy blue and gold and we are known as the Rangers. The school is a member of the Southwestern Conference of Ohio High School Athletic Association (OHSAA).
