EDUCATION COMMITTEE REPORT

Mrs. Timura, Mrs. Iezzi

Mrs. Timura stated: We have three agreements and an out of state field trip to consider under the Education Report.

The first agreement is with the Educational Service Center of Lorain County. This is an annual county service agreement which includes the following universal services: Participation in Speech and Language Supervisory Services, Audiological Services, Behavioral Specialist Support Services, Gifted and Talented Supervisory Services and Parent Mentor Services. The agreement also includes specialized district services of a Board certified behavior analyst and a district social worker. The ESC of Lorain County also provides Pathways to Success, Consortium Preschool Education Programming and Northern Ohio Research & Training Hub (NORT2H) services to North Ridgeville City Schools.

The next agreement is a multiyear agreement with Theradigm to continue providing Occupational Therapy to our students who qualify for services. This includes direct service, consultation services, assessing students, the development and writing of ETR's and IEP's, and attending meetings.

The final agreement is with the Lorain County Board of Mental Health (LCBMH) for the provision of Mental Health Consultation, Education and Prevention activities which are fully funded by the Mental Health Board and provided by mental health agencies to collaborating schools. This year Firelands Counseling is being funded by LCBMH for provision of these services within the North Ridgeville City Schools.

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Finally, there is a request to approve an overnight field trip to Boston Massachusetts from May 17-21, 2020 to attend the Edward Kennedy Institute at Yale University. This field trip is aligned to AP Government and AP English standards.

FINANCE/AUDIT REPORT

Mrs. McCarthy, Mr. Vacha

Mrs. McCarthy stated: The tax rates set by the County Auditor are required to be accepted by the Board of Education. Rates are adjusted each year in accordance with Ohio law to reflect changes in property valuations and the impact of new construction in our community. Taxes are collected for the General operations, Permanent Improvements and Debt Service based on the voted millage by the taxpayers of North Ridgeville. The rates set by the Auditor and estimated collections are consistent with the estimates calculated by the NRCS treasurer at the January Tax Budget hearing held on January 2nd, 2019 and the October 2018 5 Year Forecast as detailed below:
