



## Students of Integrity Scholarship

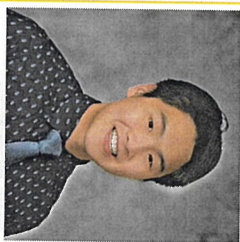
The Better Business Bureau (BBB) Students of Integrity program recognizes high school

students in Ashtabula, Cuyahoga, Geauga, Lake, and Lorain counties who, through their actions and life examples, personify ethics and strong character. Three students will be selected by a panel of judges to receive scholarships of \$1500 each, and a fourth student will be awarded a \$3500 scholarship. Additional students will also receive honorable mentions.

Each high school may select one student applicant approved by the school's counselor. **Only one application per school will be accepted.** The designated student must be scheduled to graduate during the 2023/2024 or 2024/2025 school years. Past scholarship winners are not eligible.

Winners will be notified in January. Awards will be presented at a ceremony during BBB's **Celebration of Integrity** on April 18, 2024, at Stillwater Place at Cleveland Metroparks Zoo. Winners must be able to attend.

The student will need to prepare an essay of up to 500 words describing a personal experience in which they experienced an ethical dilemma, what they did to overcome it, and how it will shape their future.
